

# Expert Witness Training – Public Intensive 1-day Course

#### **About this Course**

The provision of expert evidence is a highly technical and specialised process, and requires a very specific series of skills, which can be unfamiliar to many professionals.

Developed out of the ongoing difficulties faced by expert witnesses when providing (or looking to provide) expert evidence, this course seeks to educate expert witnesses of this process and provide detailed guidance to experts in preparing expert reports and subsequently providing expert testimony under cross examination.

This course serves as a foundation on which specialists and professionals with limited experience as an expert witness can learn more about the expert evidence process. It also serves existing and practising experts as a timely refresher in the provision of evidence. In this way expert witnesses (and their legal team, company or organisation) can be assured and confident that the expert will be well placed to provide expert evidence during all stages of the evidential process.

#### Aim

The aim of this course is to provide detailed understanding, knowledge and experience to expert witnesses on the provision of expert evidence in courts, tribunals and other legal and quasi-legal forums.

#### **Instructors**
